

New York State Softball Officials Organization, Inc. Liability Check-List

- 1. Inspect the field, backstop, all the lines, the bases, pitching plate.
- 2. Inspect <u>ALL</u> bats of <u>BOTH</u> teams. Be sure that the bats they are using are not on the banned bat list.
- 3. Inspect <u>ALL</u> helmets of <u>BOTH</u> teams. Be sure BOTH the helmet and face mask have the NOCSAE stamp. Make sure there are no cracks or lose face masks.
- 4. Remind both teams of jewelry removal as per the Jewelry Card.
- 5. Inspect catcher's helmet, chest protector, mask, shin guards.
- 6. Be alert for playing equipment on the playing field.
- 7. Regarding INJURED PLAYERS:
 - a. <u>DO NOT</u> assist, help, or move any injured player.
 - b. <u>DO NOT</u> force the removal of an injured player from the playing area. Allow coach/trainer to give necessary treatment prior to resuming play.
- 8. Regarding HAZARDS on the FIELD:
 - a. <u>DO NOT</u> remove, or help in removing any hazardous materials form the playing area.
 - b. <u>DO NOT</u> help in making a field playable after rain or similar problems.
 - c. <u>DO NOT</u> pick up equipment.
- 9. DO NOT BE A NICE PERSON!!!!!
 - a. <u>DO NOT</u> play under hazardous conditions!
 - b. DO NOT allow hazardous equipment to be used!
 - c. <u>DO NOT</u> play with spectators encroaching the field.
- 10. Players & their families may hesitate in suing the manger or coach, but the have <u>NO QUALMS</u> suing the officials!!
